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

Kenya Overview


- Three Blocks totaling more than 15,000km²

- Increased demand for energy driving onshore gas exploration






Numerous Prospects & Leads

- Pancontinental open to farminee to earn-in for drilling






Kenya L6: Onshore & Offshore Exploration

- On-trend to Wingat oil recovery
- ➤ Major farmout to Tullow Oil in late 2013
- Major Prospects being mapped on new 3D






Namibia: EL 0037



- Very large oil mature "sweet spot" exploration area
- Farmed out for extensive 3D, 2D and drilling to Tullow Oil
- Major Prospects identified on new 3D & 2D
- Mapping underway



Namibia – Future Exploration

Aggressive Current Exploration Programme

- ✓ 1,000km 2D seismic completed
- ✓ 3,000km² 3D seismic completed under farm-out to Tullow Oil
- ✓ Mapping from 3D under way

Future Program

Pancontinental 30% free-carried

- » Full 3D results will determine drilling locations
- » Pancontinental estimates farm-in expenditure up to \$130 million (100% basis)
