


## **Rig On Site to drill Cormorant-1 in PEL 37 Offshore Namibia**

Pancontinental Oil & Gas is pleased to announce that, on 3rd September 2018, the drillship Ocean Rig Poseidon transited to, and reached the drilling site of the Cormorant-1 well offshore Namibia. Drilling is expected to commence later on 3rd September or on 4th September.



Cormorant-1 will test one of a series of large Cretaceous submarine turbidite "fans".

PEL 37 is operated by Tullow Namibia Limited, a subsidiary of Tullow Oil plc. Pancontinental, with effective 20% an interest. is not required to contribute the "uncapped" to cost of drilling under a farmin "carry" by Tullow Oil.

Pancontinental Blocks PEL 37 (PCL 20%) and PEL 87 (PCL 75%) Offshore Namibia

Upon the commencement of drilling, Pancontinental will receive cash of US\$5.5 million (A\$7.5 million) from Africa Energy Corp.
