The issue had a conversion price of A\$0.008 per share which represented a 33% premium to the 30-day VWAP (volume weighted average price) of A\$0.006, an interest rate of 10% and a maturity date 12 months from the date of issue; 27 March 2018. During the Quarter, the Convertible Notes matured, and the Convertible Notes together with accrued Interest was repaid in full by cash, and as such the Company is accordingly discharged and released from all obligations and liabilities under the Convertible Notes.
