
WONMUNNA - RECONNAISSANCE DRILL RESULTS

Results from a further 3 drillholes of the reconnaissance drilling program at the NMM (Northern Marra Mamba) prospect have been received with significant (CID - >40% Fe; Marra Mamba ->50% Fe) detailed in Table 1 below. Drillhole locations are shown on Figure 1.

Reconnaissance drilling of the NMM prospect has been completed, with results pending for a further 26 drillholes.

Resource drilling of the NMM prospect is scheduled for commencement in early March, 2008.
