## DRILLING RECOMMENCES AT SPRINGFIELD PROJECT

Talisman Mining Ltd (ASX: **TLM**) is pleased to advise that drilling has re-commenced at its 100%-owned **Springfield Copper-Gold Project** in Western Australia.

A diamond drill rig commenced operations today at Springfield. It is anticipated that diamond drilling will continue at Springfield throughout the calendar year.



Additionally, programs of reconnaissance RC and RAB drilling are scheduled to take place throughout the year at the Springfield Project with an RC drill rig currently scheduled to commence drilling in late February 2011.

Drilling will be initially focused at the high priority **Homer**, **Monty** and **CCO2 Prospects** where exploration to date has provided significant, geological encouragement.
