## TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF DRILLING AT SPRINGFIELD PROJECT

---

Talisman Mining Ltd (ASX: **TLM**) advises that drilling and field exploration activities at its 100%-owned **Springfield Copper-Gold Project** located in the upper Gascoyne/Murchison region in Western Australia have been temporarily suspended due to adverse weather conditions.

There has been significant widespread rainfall throughout the interior of Western Australia resulting in significant stream rises and flooding that has affected active field operations and access within the Springfield Project. Talisman has placed priority on the safety of all staff and contractors and has completed the evacuation of all personnel from these projects.

Field exploration and diamond drilling activities will recommence as soon as practically possible and once recommenced are scheduled to continue at the Springfield project throughout the calendar year.
