

## KDL ROUGH DIAMOND AUCTION REACHES RECORD PRICES


(ASX:KDL) Kimberley Diamonds Limited ("KDL" or "Kimberley") the owner and operator of the Ellendale Diamond Project ("Ellendale") in Western Australia, is pleased to announce it has achieved the highest price per carat for its rough diamonds at auction since it took over ownership of Ellendale in February 2013.

The overall price achieved of US\$207.33 per carat is 17.2% higher than the previous sales price of US\$178 per carat in December, adjusted for sales mixtures. The auction saw prices rise across all rough diamond sizes and resulted in a total sales of US\$3.92m.

Yesterday's auction in Antwerp, Belgium was carried out through KDL's online auction platform eDiamond and consisted of 18,903 carats of commercial quality goods from the Ellendale Mine. These gem-quality rough diamonds fall outside those which are sold in the off-take agreement with high-end global jeweller Tiffany & Co's cutting and polishing arm Laurelton.

KDL Executive Chairman Alex Alexander commented:"The demand for these Ellendale rough diamonds was very strong and this outstanding price per carat result confirms market feedback that rough prices are increasing strongly".
